### Explanatory Notes:

- **A grade '4' is equivalent to a grade C.** A grade '4' is the nearest equivalent to a grade C and is the expected grade for admission to Post 16 study programmes.
- **A grade '5' is equivalent to an upper grade C / lower grade B.**
- **Progress 8** is used to measure student progress against peers nationally of a similar ability level. The measure for the school will be published in October.
- **Ebacc** is a measure used to indicate the percentage of students who achieved a grade '5' in a suite of specific subjects covering English, Maths, Science, a language and either History or Geography. It is not a qualification in, and of itself. Whilst we offer a full Ebacc programme, it is not compulsory at Thomas Keble as we prefer a personalised KS4 curriculum approach.
