What is GARAS

GARAS supports those seeking asylum in Gloucestershire, welcoming them when they arrive, supporting them in their daily struggles, supporting them if they face being sent back and helping them adjust to their long-term future if they are recognised as 'refugees'. We work with those arriving within the asylum process and those being resettled here.

Why help?

Asylum seekers are forced to live of benefits; the average allowance is £72. This is simply not enough for a family to survive on, by donating and campaigning, we can give asylum seekers the opportunity to have a new life, with comfort and necessities by giving them the right to work. We are also campaigning to allow asylum seekers to be able to work as this is currently against the law.

How can you help?

You can help us and GARAS by donating or asking your parents to donate. A donation box will be in reception until December 19th. We suggest hygiene products, canned food or clothes.

- Stationary (Pens, pencils, pencil cases)
